Bush Rules

- Bedding is provided, please bring you own towels, flashlights and ice and a warm jacket.
- Guests visit the farm at their own risk.
- Drive slowly at ALL times and always be on the lookout for game.
- No person, guest or visitor, will be allowed on the property without having signed an indemnity.
- Strictly no pets will be allowed in the camp or conservation areas.
- No rubbish or cigarette butts may be thrown/dumped in our around the camp and conservation areas.
- No fires may be made except in designated areas. Unusually large fires in the lapa are not allowed.
- In the event that a fire is started due to negligence, by either an out of control campfire, cigarette butt or similar source, the party involved will be billed in totality for any and all losses and/or damages caused by the fire.
- No air guns and/or slingshots (ketties) are allowed on the property.
- All firearms must be handed in to the farm manager, where after they will be kept in a safe until departure.
- No-one may handle any firearms on the property.
- No alcoholic beverages may be provided to persons under the legal age required for participation (18 years old).
- No person may make use of the farm vehicles.
- In the event that a guest is found to be in contravention of our rules and regulations, this person will be immediately removed from the property without prejudice and with no liability to the owner and/or their representatives and/or staff.
- Please use water and firewood sparingly, they are valuable in the bushveld.
- Please be sure to close any gates that were closed behind yourself, this includes the main gate.

- No persons will be allowed in the breeding camps.
- Please remember that wild animals are moving around freely on the property at all times.
- Please be careful at all times – Wild animals remain WILD!
